Upon completion of the course, participants will be able to:

- identify what intoxication means and looks like.
- handle situations involving minors.
- use an effective approach to discontinue or refuse to sell or serve alcohol
- understand your legal responsibilities and liabilities.

Upon successfully completing the workshop each participant will receive a certificate for your records.

There is usually a cost of \$50 for this workshop, but the workshop is free with a paid registration to the SAASE convention. Space is limited to 20 people for this workshop – in order to give as many Agricultural Societies access to the workshop – only 1 person from each Agricultural Society will be able to register.
